1. **PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED FROM PROPOSITION 1B FUNDS** (continued from July P/F meeting & recommendation from Infrastructure/Facilities Committee) – Steve Flaigg, Building Inspector  
In response to a recommendation by the Infrastructure/Facilities Committee to use Prop. 1B funds for relocation of the transit transfer station committee, Steve provided an estimate of the relocation costs. The committee agreed to the use of Prop. 1B funds for the relocation. Because there may be Prop. 1B funds remaining after the transit project, staff was asked to research the possibility of building a heliport at the Hydrox property.
